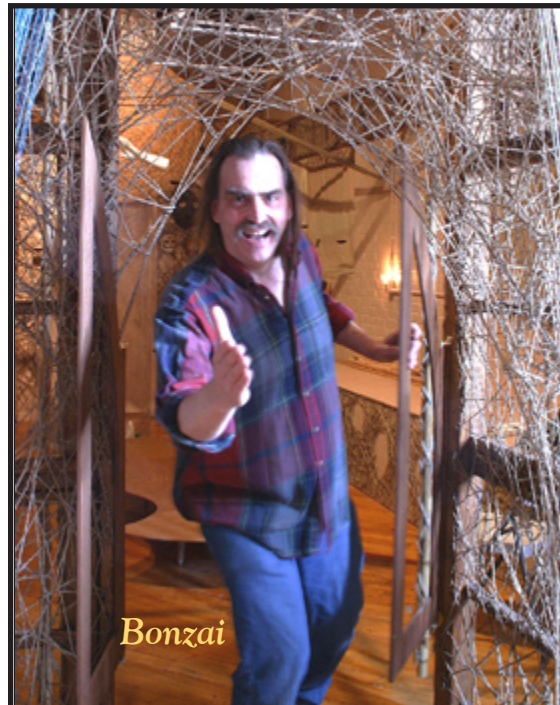


## Meet The Staff At The Territory Bank
