Why We Need Pamphlets

You and me, we get pamphlets all the time. Usually they have to do with some money thing they're advertising. But really, they could be so much more, I mean why don't people just circulate their ideas without money being involved? This isn't so crazy if you think it through, why only just a few centuries ago there were lots of pamphlets going around and the guys who wrote them were known about town as pamphleteers. This was just after the printing press started, and pamphlets became a well known way to reach other people with certain ideas that were not a part of the organized flow. The trouble with the printing press though, you had to run off a whole lot of copies to make each one cheap enough. But now that's not so. Just about everyone has a computer and a printer too, you can run off a pamphlet on a sheet of paper, fold it in thirds and there you are. And the great thing is, you can print them out on an ongoing basis as the need arises. Which means you can have lots and lots of different pamphlets in limited quantities at a very low expense.

It seems hard to believe that we aren't doing this already, it's such a simple thing to do. Is it because we don't have any personal ideas anymore? Or maybe it's because we've been told somehow in an ongoing way (by society let's say) that's it's really much better to receive an idea than to initiate one. A good little

citizen should really pursue some society sanctioned goal, they don't want anyone bringing into play a more personal longing or spiritual remembering. So what I say is let's all make pamphlets! I'll do it if you will (I'll even do it if you don't).

One of the great things about pamphlets is their shortness. I don't know about you, but I know about me and I've always had a lot of ideas that are only just that, ideas - I mean I wouldn't want to write a whole book about them. But short ideas are often dismissed right away at the start. In the everyday world of society we've been told that we have to plan it all out and have lots of backing to carry things through. An idea has to be practical and it really should be profitable too, or so society says. But actually, it seems to me that ideas don't have to be practical at all, and the best ideas I've heard inside are rarely very profitable in an everyday sort of way. But society wants us to go through channels with our ideas. Have someone else publish them and basically change or weed out the ones that don't fit the status quo. They don't want no unsettling styles, I mean there's grammar and spelling and other such stuff you gotta stay in step with and people should be polite to each other (although society hardly ever is).

Personally I think it's more polite to give someone a pamphlet about what you think than to bend their ear or rearrange your position on them so they have to listen to it. I mean why not just hand

them a pamphlet and then, if they're a reasonable person, they'll read it and consider it. Or throw it away. Cause you can throw away a pamphlet you see, and that's a good thing because ideas should really just come and go without attachment.
